OUR ACCOMPLISHMENTS

 We are committed to fostering a positive and supportive learning environment while identifying areas for growth in community engagement and academic performance.

Milk River Elementary School:

- 1. **Citizenship**: Despite a drop to 65.5%, the school maintains a focus on promoting citizenship values.
- Welcoming and Safe Environment: The Welcoming, Caring, Respectful, and Safe Learning Environments (WCRSLE) measure is at 71.5%, indicating progress in fostering an inclusive school culture.
- Teacher Satisfaction: Teachers consistently report high agreement (100%) on student engagement, highlighting strong instructional practices.

Erle Rivers High School:

- High School Completion: A standout accomplishment is a 3-year high school completion rate of 91.7%, rated "Very High," showcasing exceptional success in supporting students toward graduation.
- 2. **Teacher Engagement**: Teachers' agreement on student learning engagement is consistently high at 96.7%, reflecting strong teaching quality.
- Numeracy and Literacy: Parents report a high level of satisfaction with numeracy and literacy skills being taught, indicating a solid foundation in essential academic.

Two-Way Communication: Engaging the community requires establishing channels for open, transparent, and ongoing communication. Regular newsletters, social media updates, and surveys help gather feedback and keep the community informed about school initiatives and achievements.
