Outdoor supervision will begin at 8:15 A.M. Students will enter the school at 8:25 A.M. through their designated doors on the east side of the school (Early Learning, Kindergarten, Grade 1 & 2) and northeast (Grades 3, 4, 5 & 6). All Grade 7 - 12 students will enter through the front doors.

We request that if your child will not be attending school, that you please notify the school each time they will be away. We in turn will attempt to phone you if we find your child absent and have not heard from you. It is much easier, however, for you to make one phone call or message (to both Karmen & Sheina) than for us to make many!

A monthly calendar and newsletter will be posted on **School Dojo** at the beginning of each month. Updates and additional information notices will be posted periodically to account for any changes that you need to be informed of.
